



NOTICE OF RACE

Northumberland Challenge

NStYA Championship Series 2016

Yachts race from Charlottetown Harbour, PE to St. Peter's Island and return to Charlottetown. This race is approximately 25 n/m in length.

Note: This is a category B Race

1. **Race:** Northumberland Challenge
2. **Start Location:** *Charlottetown Yacht Club Start Line*
3. **Finish Location:** *Charlottetown Yacht Club Finish Line*
4. **Date:** September 10, 2016
5. **Organizing Authorities:** Charlottetown Yacht Club in cooperation with the NStYA.

7. **Rules:** Race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association, the Notice of Race, and where modified by the sailing instructions. Charlottetown Yacht Club race committees and Jury will have final authority on all matters.
8. **Eligibility:** The owner & skipper must be a current member of their national governing body, i.e.: local sailors must be a member of the Canadian Yachting Association and the NStYA. Yachts must have a valid NSYA PHRF rating.
9. **Classes:** A, B, C and D Classes. A minimum of four boats must be registered in order to comprise a NStYA Championship race.
10. **Fees:** \$25.00 Per Boat for NStYA annual registration, plus \$5 starter fee (\$30 total).
11. **Inspection & Measurement:** Yachts are required to have the appropriate safety requirement in accordance with Transport Canada/CCG regulations and NStYA requirements. Yachts may be inspected at any time prior to or immediately after the race.
12. **Registration:** 10:00am – 11:00am on September 10, 2016 at CYC.
13. **Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration.
14. **Skippers' Meeting:** 11:15am
15. **Start:** 12:00pm
16. **Scoring:** NStYA Championship Series low scoring system in effect.
17. **Insurance:** All yacht must show proof of 1,000,000.00 liability insurance.
18. **Prizes/flags:** NStYA flags for the top three finishers in each class and first overall.
